
SETTING THE SECURITY SETTINGS ON YOUR COMPUTER TO USE SOFTWARE NOT MADE BY THE MANUFACTURER, LIKE GYST

For Macs:

You will only need to do this if you have the most recent OS 10.8.4

Open up your system preferences buy clicking on the apple at the top left of your desktop.

Click on the Security and Privacy. You will need to check the Anywhere button. See below.




You may also need to set up security on the file itself. We recommend you do this to the installer before installing, as well as the folder itself, located in the Applications Folder. Highlight/click once on the GYST Folder.

Then use Command-I to open the information window. At the bottom, make sure that the file is not locked (see lock icon). Make sure that the file itself has Read and Write listed for all users.

Hit OK.

For PC users: This is for all Windows machines. Open up your Hard Drive C: Find the GYST folder and right-click on the folder.
Select properties at the bottom of the pop up screen
Once you are there, sell full control for all the items listed. (First, select the item here



Then set full control by clicking on the boxes below. It may take a few tries.

Also, select General and make sure that the Read Only box at the bottom is NOT selected. Click Apply to set it up.
